#### **PREREQUISITES:**

The Bloomington Matrimonial Service conducts its practices based on the <u>Qur'an</u> and the sayings and traditions of <u>Prophet Muhammad PBUH</u>. Accordingly, marriage ceremonies are conducted between a man and a woman who will be able to acquire a civil marriage license.

#### Process:

Muslims seeking marriage may view (not take) the questionnaire (Marriage Profile) and download it from here then send it to <a href="mailto:imam@icob.org">imam@icob.org</a>

This profile covers personal details, expectations of marriage, financial expectations, family information, expectations regarding children, religious expectations, intimacy expectations, and personal references.

You have our full <u>Amanah</u>. Any candidate's name, contact information, and personal references will **NOT** be shared without their prior knowledge.

If the candidate has a particular person in mind, that person will be asked if they are interested in marriage, and if so, both parties will have the option to fill out a questionnaire to determine compatibility. The initiating party can choose to reveal his/her identity. If both parties believe they're compatible, the matter will be handed off to either those parties or their representatives.

If a candidate doesn't have a particular person in mind but is seeking marriage, the profile will be examined and they will then be either matched with another candidate seeking marriage, or their profile will be filed until a compatible profile is available.

If a compatible profile is available, both candidates will be notified and able to review the other party's profile, with names redacted. If both parties feel they're compatible, they will be given the option to reveal their names, contact information, and personal references to the other party, and the matter will be handed off to either those parties or their representatives.

## **PURPOSE:**

The purpose of this initiative is to promote obedience and devotion to Allah in our community by helping Muslims find spouses in a halal way.

This is a confidential profile that you will complete to determine a potential spouse for you, Insha'Allah. You will be answering very personal and possibly sensitive questions:

- ➤ Honesty is crucial. A lack of honesty will only hurt your ability to find a spouse or will harm your future marriage.
- ➤ Please be aware that the Islamic Center will not assist in cases of haram marriage requests or illegal marriage requests.
- > You may include a headshot (picture) of yourself if you wish, but it is not necessary. If you include a photo, it will not be revealed to a potential spouse without your permission.
- > Your identity will not be revealed to a potential spouse without your permission.
- > Your profile will not be available for unauthorized people to view without your permission.
- ➤ Please answer these questions to the best of your ability and with as much detail as possible.
